


Newsletter March 2021

This brings us onto Membership fees for the coming season, which we are pleased to advise will be unchanged from last year, however, we have clarified the Full and Roll-up membership as below:-

Life Membership (Free) - Members can participate in all bowling and social aspects of the club, and are entitled to vote at General Meetings (eg an AGM).

Full Membership (£60) - Members can participate in all bowling and social aspects of the club, and are entitled to vote at General Meetings (eg an AGM). Full membership is required for all Management Committee Members in season 2021.

Roll-up Membership (£25) - This is an associate membership for participation in roll-ups and social aspects only, it does not include participation in any Leagues, County or Club Competitions - for this Full Membership is required. A roll-up member may attend General Meetings but cannot vote.

Junior Member (£10) - Bowling and Social Membership for juniors up to the age of 18, with no voting rights.

Social Membership (£10) - This a non-bowling membership entitling participation in all social events and access to club facilities. with no voting rights.

Roll-up day is traditionally Tuesday afternoons, however, League or other formal matches will take preference, therefore, this may be moved or cancelled.

It would be great to have your membership fees as soon possible please! Cheques payable to STBC or contact Richard Adams for bank details.

The club requires a new volunteer to run the Over 60's 'A' Team for the forth coming season. Could members interested please put yourself forward and contact, Joy Kent directly in order that we can start as soon as the league begins.

We will issue further communications as and when more information becomes available nearer the proposed Opening Day.
